Planning

24122: Planning, new applications:

a. No new planning applications received.

24123: Planning ongoing:

- No further update from Hannah Blackburn in the area planning department regarding the corporate complaint raised in November 2022 with them in relation to 2022/0357/TCA. Hellings House, 73 Main Street, Escrick - the tree work and 2021/1375/HPA.
- b. ZG2023/0691/HPA. Grove House Skipwith Road. Gas tank relocation. Revised plans have been submitted to NYC. The Internal Drainage Board has been in direct correspondence with the applicant and agreed a plan. Accordingly, strictly on the basis of the works being carried out in accordance with "Site & Location Plan" Revision C dated 08.04.2024 the Board has no objection to the proposal. However, to date no progress has been made to relocate the gas tank.
- c. 2023/0110/FUL Traves A, Abattoir, Main Street, Escrick, YO19 6JP.

24124: Planning determinations:

a. ZG2023/0691/HPA. Grove House, Skipwith Road. Installation of submerged gas tank in the front garden and replace existing tarmac driveway with permeable materials (part retrospective). APPROVED.

24125: Other planning matters:

- b. North Yorkshire Council Local Plan. Call for sites issued.

Highways items

24126: Streetlighting:

a. Street light no.1 (Skipwith Road) is now working. Cllr Allen to report back on the damaged post on the junction of Skipwith Road.

24127: A19 traffic:

- a. Pedestrian safety crossing the A19 at the junction of Skipwith Road. NYC have looked into the possibility of installing a barrier on the pedestrian refuge. They have reported that this would not meet technical approval due to the width of the island. If one could be installed it could reduce the area where pedestrians stand and would obstruct the drivers view of a person with a child or in a pushchair.
- b. Cllr King is investigating installing a high powered solar powered light at the York bound bus stop on the A19. To send details to CYC when received and report back to councillors.
